- ☐ Ensure tube placement and security
  - Verify placement (auscultation, capnography)
  - Secure tube
  - Place OG tube (optional)
  - Obtain CXR
- ☐ Review CXR
- □ Order vent settings
- ☐ Ensure post-intubation sedation
- ☐ Avoid hyperoxia
