• Mentorship Day

• Higher Education Basic Needs and Human Rights Survey

- This is the first-in-the-nation statewide study to assess the prevalence of food and housing insecurity among everyone (faculty, staff, and students) in public higher education institutions in New Mexico, funded by the Governor's Food Initiative and the Higher Education Department.
- It is the creation of an interdisciplinary research team of UNM faculty, staff, and students from the Honors College, Nutrition, Population Health, Anderson and Law Schools. Your participation will help produce evidence regarding the health of the higher education workforce, and reveal additional information concerning food and housing insecurity among our students, not just at UNM but within higher education across the state. The data will be used to inform the Basic Needs Grand Challenge and the creation of evidence-based interventions. Questions can be directed to Dr. Sarita Cargas at basicneeds@unm.edu.

• Community Based Participatory Research (CBPR)

- CBPR, and related-Participatory Action Research (PAR) & Community-Engaged Research (CEnR), is defined as a "collaborative approach that equitably involves all partners....with the aim of combining knowledge and action for social change to improve health and eliminate health disparities" (Kellogg Foundation). Not simply a set of research methods, CBPR, or community-engaged research fundamentally changes the relationship between researchers and the researched.
- For graduate students, post-doctoral fellows, faculty, researchers, community partners/researchers, academic-community teams, health professionals, scholar-activists, and others. This is an intensive co-learning institute to explore how CBPR intersects with indigenous and critical methodologies, including the challenges for academics and community members to co-construct knowledge for improved health equity.
- Set to take place May 17th & May 22nd-26th, 2023
- If not enrolled for credit: \$1050 for faculty/researchers; \$700 for research staff or health/social service professionals; \$600 for non-credit students/fellows; \$300 for community members.
