- Campus safety is going to improve lighting in G and Q lots around the end of May.
- Best forms of communication for student affairs to reach students: bulletin board on website and announcement section, teams, etc.
- RR students propose to have more equal access and ask what is being done to integrate it into the UNM community more (building access with badges, lactation room)
 - Response: lack of personnel is the main obstacle. SRMC is main overseer of RR campus.

- We are working out the logistics of using HSSC budget money to stock the pantry.
- The Menstrual Equity Pilot Program will be adding a basket of hygiene products to the pantry and the Student Nursing Association has also reached out to provide period products for the pantry.
